Maintain tanks, service vehicles, bobtails, dispensers, and bulk tank facility.

Complete daily vehicle inspection forms, and detailed workorders for each job.

Unload transport tanks into bulk plant.

Load bobtail, perform bobtail deliveries in all weather conditions. Complete daily shift reports.

Communicate with dispatcher daily to review work schedule.

Perform sales calls and provide written job estimates.

Smoke free facility and vehicles.

CDL, Class B with hazmat and air brakes

Drug free (subject to pre-employment and random drug screenings)

Background check

- mechanical background and plumbing experience

Physical requirements include:

- able to detect the odor of odorized propane
- able to pull a 50# hose a distance of 125', over rough and uneven terrain.
- able to install and remove tire chains when required.
- able to push or pull tanks weighing 300 pounds using a hand truck or dolly
- frequent bending and twisting in small spaces, stooping and kneeling
- walking on un-even and sometimes slippery, wet conditions
